More extra-curricular clubs such as choir and netball are missed.	We have begun a choir during lunchtimes and we have a range of extra-curricular clubs during the year – netball is one sport offered
I think more could be done for pupils who may need extra help for their mental health.	This is something we will continue to work on. We try to ensure that we have some opportunities during the year to have visitors and enhancement weeks where the focus is on

	the foundation subjects and more mental health focused activities. Our PHSRE curriculum covers looking after your mental health.
I would like my child to have more homework.	This is a fine balance to strike – our staff provide several homework activities to complete during the week – there is always a range of tasks that can be found online at providers such as 'Oak Academy' for free.
Learning logs – I don't seen the benefit, they are not marked.	All our teachers value the work and effort pupils put into their learning logs. They are displayed and applauded in class and in achievement assemblies.
We don't always get updates about interventions	Interventions are reported at parents' evening or in a pupil's annual report – only if they attend one.
I would like to see more sports teams like football, netball and rounders. Maybe cookery or art clubs for a term.	Thank you for your suggestion, we do offer some of these but we will look into others.
It's difficult to know what our child is doing on a day to day basis. The odd photo on twitter would encourage them to talk about his day.	We try to keep the website current with things we have done in school. It is difficult to maintain the level of twitter coverage for pupils further up school.
Since the change of management we feel the focus of well-being has been towards the teaching staff as opposed to the pupils.	Everyone's mental health and well-being is considered at Healey, pupils and teachers. Healey is lucky to have hard working staff as well as pupils. It is important to look after all who attend here as the school would have a very different feel if the well-being of all wasn't maintained.
