School uniform and PE Kit

Children are not allowed to bring toys or jewellery into school.

Earrings need to be sleepers or studs, no children should wear rings or necklaces/bracelets.

No child is allowed to wear nail polish.

School footwear

Children cannot wear trainers for school. They must have black shoes.

For PE they must have sports trainers, not converse/casual trainers.

School Uniform for PE

Children's PE kit must be a white t shirt and black shorts **NOT** Football shirts or different coloured t shirts.

For outdoor PE children should wear dark jogging bottoms and white t-shirt.

We have many children coming to school with no PE kit or wearing their school polo shirt for PE – this is not permitted.
